

Citrus Fruits (Andalucía, C. Valenciana y Región de Murcia)

The Mediterranean climate in Spain is ideal for growing different varieties of fruit. All regions have a common characteristic, dry summer with low rainfall.



Mediterranean Fruits (Andalucía, C. Valenciana, Región de Murcia, Cataluña y Castilla La Mancha)

Spain is the Mediterranean country that produces the most citrus fruits. Due to the climatic conditions, careful cultivation and harvesting, Spanish citrus fruits have a high quality guarantee.



Stone Fruits (Extremadura, Región de Murcia, Aragón y Cataluña)

Stone fruits are named for their hard pit encased in fleshy fruit. They don't ripen after harvest, so they're picked at peak ripeness and have a short season.



Tropical Fruits (Mexico, Costa Rica, Brazil, India y China)

A tropical fruit is a fruit from tropical or subtropical climate zones. What characterizes tropical fruits is not the geographical area where they grow but mainly the surrounding climate.
